# Accommodation

# A typical day

**07.00** - School staff wake up the group

**08.15** - Breakfast (English or Continental, cereal, toast, drinks)

**09.00** - First activity session, including a break at an appropriate time

**12.30** - Hot lunch or packed lunch

**13.15** – Second activity session, including a break

**16.15** - Supervised free time

**17.30** - Evening meal

**18.30** - Evening entertainment

**20.30** – Getting ready for bed

**21.00** – Bed time

Through the night there will always be a senior centre staff member on call.

# Kit List

**Clothing – take plenty of clothing in case of wet weather  
(clothing should be old)**

- Nightwear
- Underwear
- Several pairs of socks, at least one thick pair
- Soft flat shoes- clean trainers or soled slippers for indoor use.  
NO Slipper socks, flip flops or novelty slippers allowed
- Waterproof coat and trousers are essential
- Clean casual clothes for indoor wear
- Outdoor shoes- walking boots or outdoor trainers
- Trousers, joggers, leggings etc (2 pairs or more) NO Jeans please



# Kit List

- Warm coat
- Wellington boots
- 2 sweaters/sweatshirts
- Woollen hat and gloves
- T.shirts/long sleeved (2 or more)
- Towel
- Wash kit (Soap, toothbrush etc)- No aerosols

During the colder times of the year, the following will provide extra layers for warmth: extra jumpers or T-shirts (preferably long-sleeved), leggings, or similar

# Extras

- Small day rucksack and a suitable container for packed lunch – both items clearly labelled with your child's name
- Small torch-optional
- Plastic watertight bottle, marked with owner's name for the packed lunch drink Plastic named bin liner for wet or dirty clothes

# Contact

- If you need to contact your child please contact the school in the first instance
- We will send text updates to families via the school office

# Miscellaneous

- No electrical items/mobile phones/cameras
- All clothing should be marked with name and school.
- Medication – named bag with instructions
- Brand new, expensive items should be left at home
- Try to limit luggage to one case/bag per person and one item of hand luggage for carrying lunch etc.

# Contracts and behaviour

- 1. To be respectful of others considering peoples feelings and safety.**

- 3. To respect and be responsible for the property issued by the site.**
- 4. To listen to the adults and follow instruction.**
- 5. To be respectful of all adults and peers. NO aggressive behaviour will be tolerated.**
- 6. To remain in your accommodation at bedtime until an adult instructs you otherwise.**
- 7. To remain with your group at ALL times.**

**Any anti social behaviour will NOT be acceptable and Broadstone First School reserve the right to exclude anyone whose behaviour is deemed to be so. Parents should be aware that if the contract is not adhered to, you will be contacted and asked to remove your child at any time of the day or night.**
