### **Music Tuition - September 2021 to July 2022**

We are pleased to announce from September we have an experienced music teacher joining us at both Broadstone First and Middle. This will be an incredible opportunity for all students as we will be able to provide a wider variety of a music in our curriculum than before.

We are also pleased to provide in house music tuition (like our sports clubs) and this will be available to our pupils who will be in Year 2, 3 and 4 from September.

Pupils will receive 30 lessons during the school year and it is imperative that payment is made via ParentPay by the dates detailed below. If there is a genuine reason for non-payment by the due date, a letter must be addressed to the Head of School explaining the reason, minimum of 5 days before the due date. You will be sent a text message one week prior to the payment due date as a reminder if you have not already paid.
