Music Offer- September 2022 to July 2023

We are pleased to announce our Music offer for 2022-2023. Mr Neville Bluck will continue to deliver specialist music sessions across school. This will continue to allow us to provide a wider variety of music within our curriculum.

We are also pleased to provide in house music tuition and this will be available to our pupils who will be in Year 1, 2, 3 and 4 from September.

Instrument	Year Group (From Sept 22)	Time	Cost per Term (10 weeks)
Recorder Mr N Bluck	1, 2, 3 and 4	During the school day x 30-minute session	£27.50 plus the cost of purchasing the tuition book and own recorder (purchased separately – more details to follow)
Choir Mr N Bluck	2, 3, and 4	During lunchtime	No charge

Pupils will receive 30 lessons during the school year and it is imperative that payment is made via ParentPay by the dates detailed below. If there is a genuine reason for non-payment by the due date, a letter must be addressed to the Head of School explaining the reason, minimum of 5 days before the due date. You will be sent a text message one week prior to the payment due date as a reminder if you have not already paid.
