Dear Parents/Carers

Strike Days – Thursday 27 April and Tuesday 02 May

I am writing to inform you that we will need to close for all pupils, on Thursday 27 April and Tuesday 02 May, except for those we deem "vulnerable pupils" and for those children whose families BOTH work in front-line services.

"Front-line" means 'blue-light' provision such as Paramedics, Doctors, Nurses and Police. If you fall into either of these categories, we will be contacting you directly to offer a place in school on Thursday 27 April and Tuesday 02 May. If you haven't heard from us by 1pm Monday 24 April, and feel you fall into either of these categories, please contact the school office to confirm your job title and work requirements.

On line learning will be available for all pupils should you wish to access it.

We are hoping that in letting you know about these arrangements, before the actual day of the strike, you will be able to make alternative arrangements for childcare.
