Morning and Afternoon Club – Spring Term 2023

We are delighted to be writing to you with arrangements for our morning and after school clubs from 03 January 2023 (Spring Term).

Morning Club

We will be continuing morning club as normal, this will run from 8am-8.30am. To secure a place for morning club the process will be slightly different from in the past due to our new payment system Weduc. Please see the below for more information:

To book your child a space you will need to log in to the payment side of Weduc and select the days you require. Unfortunately, we will no longer be allowed to take on the day drop ins, if you need to register for morning club at a later date this will still be available in the Weduc App (even the night before) throughout the Spring Term. We as a school will print off an attendance register via Weduc each morning to confirm which children should be attending morning club.

After School Club

At BFS we are passionate about preparing children for a life well lived. It is important to us that we provide a range of opportunities for our learners in order to develop well rounded individuals.

All after school clubs will run from 3.15pm until 4pm. Each club will be run by a member of our BFS staff or an external coach currently being utilised across the school who have already established positive relationships, know the children and how we work as a school, benefiting the children greatly. Due to our new payment system we are able to offer new ways of paying, please see the below for more information:

The price of the club is per a child and £2.50 per session, if you would like to make your payment in full this will be due by Tuesday 03 January 2023. However, we are pleased to be able to offer the opportunity to pay in 3 instalments via Weduc – you will need to make sure this payment plan is still set up in Weduc by 03 January 2023.

It is important to note: Even paying monthly you are still liable for the whole term's fees if you cancel your child's space at a later date due to staffing costs.

We are really excited to announce that we have two new externally run clubs commencing for Spring Term.

Tennis Club will be delivered by Broadstone Tennis Club. Two qualified instructors and the children will be walk over to the Junction tennis courts for their session to utilise their facilities and then must be collected at 4pm from the tennis courts. Our children will be accompanied by a member of BFS staff both on the walk over to the Junction and for the duration of the session. Year 2 children attending tennis on Tuesday will be permitted to wear their PE kit into school for the day in readiness for their club after school.

Zumba Club will be delivered in the BFS hall and again our qualified Zumba instructor will be accompanied by a member of BFS staff for the duration of the club and dismissal.
