Aims of Visit:	To learn about the history and geography of Poole Town, The Quay and its links with local pirate “Harry Paye”.
Activities Outlined:	Harry Paye pirate workshop provided by Poole Museum at school. To follow the “Cockle” Trail around Old Town and the Quay front learning more about the history and geography of Poole.
Clothing:	<p>The workshop encourages children and adults to wear “pirate style” outfits (these should be comfortable and practical).</p> <p>Children will also be walking around Poole Quay, so the outfit needs to be suitable for this too i.e. flat comfortable footwear.</p>
Children need to bring:	A named bag, waterproof coat and a water bottle.
Lunch:	<p>If you have ordered a meal for your child for this day, a packed lunch will be provided instead.</p> <p>If you have <u>not</u> ordered a lunch from Chartwells please provide a packed lunch.</p> <p>All children should bring a PE style string bag or rucksack with them to hold their lunch and drink or water.
