School Times

All classroom doors will be open from 8.30am-8.40am for children to arrive. The register will then be taken promptly at 8.40am and the school day will start.

The school gates will shut a few minutes before 8.40am, allowing enough time for children to reach their classroom doors, anyone arriving after the gate closes will be classed as late and will need to sign into school via the school office. It is very important that children establish good routines and habits in preparation for the rest of their lives. It is essential that you ensure that your child arrives at school on time to prevent disruption to your child's own learning and that of others.

The end of the school day is at **3.05pm**. The school gates will open at 3.05pm for you to collect your child from their classroom door. We ask that you arrive promptly for collection. We have a number of after school clubs each night, so ask that once collecting your child you leave the school ground promptly.

Entrance and Exit into School

Both side gates, the gate leading into the main playground and side gate in front of the main office will be open for entering and exiting the school. A member of the Senior Leadership Team will always be on the gate to greet you; however, we do ask that you always keep your child close to you for safeguarding reasons. This ensures all children leave the site safely and with their trusted adult.

<u>Uniform</u>

We ask that you support us in ensuring that all children arrive in school in the correct uniform. If you have any questions about this, please do not hesitate to contact school or refer to the uniform policy on the website. If you are unsure whether a piece of uniform is acceptable, please consult us before purchasing.
