Aims of Visit: To understand when, how and why Stonehenge was built and

discover what life was like in Neolithic times.

Activities Outlined: During this Discovery Visit, learners will become archaeologists,

discovering Stonehenge through a variety of models and artefacts to answer key questions. This will be followed by hands-on activities at

the Neolithic houses.
