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## Trip Information Continued

Aims of Visit:	To learn about short term effects of World War II, particularly the evacuation of children from major cities.
Activities Outlined:	WW2 Evacuation Experience in an historical fort
Clothing:	World War Two Era clothing (recommended)
Children need to bring:	Packed lunch in a bag, disposable water bottle, waterproof layer.
Lunch:	<p>If you have ordered a meal for your child for this day, a packed lunch will be provided instead.</p> <p>If you have <u>not</u> ordered a lunch please provide a packed lunch in a named plastic bag to enable us to dispose of all litter at lunchtime – <i><u>please do not send lunch boxes.</u></i></p> <p>All children should bring a PE style string bag or rucksack with them to hold their lunch and two additional cartons of drink or water. Please ensure all items are named. The children will be expected to carry these items themselves.</p>

Payment Information:	Parents are reminded that if we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. Please contact the Head of School if you are unable to contribute because of financial difficulties.

To enhance the evacuee experience, we encourage learners to come dressed in the style of an evacuee. This is optional, although highly encouraged. To support this, learners will create name tags and luggage tags in the classroom. **Additional themed clothing will need to be provided from home.** Many of the items you may wish to use for a costume can be found at low prices in charity shops or at home – for instance, boys can wear school shorts or trousers, girls can wear a grey school pinafore or similar.
