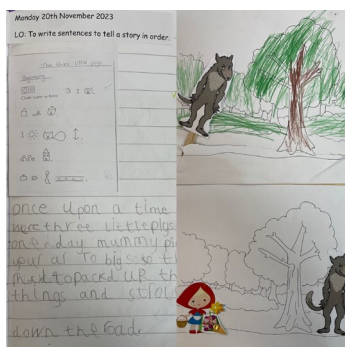

Year 1

Year 3

It has been another fantastic week of learning in Year 3. We have started our new module 'In the Shadows' and the children are very excited to start learning about light in their science lessons and about contrast in Art and Design. In Maths, we moved onto learning our 3, 4 and 8 times tables. In English, we have been learning about fiction books, looking at 'The Little Match Girl' and 'The Nutcracker'.
